SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

History and Purpose

The Saint John's #51 scholarship foundation was founded to offer scholarship support to students interested in continuing their education at a college or university. The number and amount of the scholarship awards can vary depending on the amount raised during the year and the number of applicants.

<u>Criteria</u>

Recipients are selected according the following criteria:

- Applicants must be a graduating senior from a Texas high school within the jurisdiction
 of Saint John's #51 Lodge, a graduating high school senior or a current full time college
 undergraduate attendee. Masonic relationship is not required, but will be given first
 consideration when funds are limited.
- Recipients will be chosen by the Scholarship Committee and selections forwarded for final approval by the lodge. <u>Recipients will be chosen from complete applications only</u> and submitted by eligible students based on the following criteria:
 - a. Academic performance/potential as indicated on transcripts and a letter of recommendation.
 - b. Proof of attending a Texas High School or attending an accredited University or college.
 - c. Personal essay: The four cardinal virtues of Ancient Free & Accepted Masons are: Prudence, Temperance, Fortitude, and Justice. Choose one of these virtues and describe how it applies to your future leadership role in your chosen profession.

Essays shall be not less than 500 words, double spaced, with proper source attribution for all references. submitted in hard copy or as a properly formatted text file accompanying the application. Essays shall be submitted in American Psychological Association 6th or 7th Edition, or Chicago Manual of Style publishing formats. Qualifying essays will be judged on the following criteria:

- Being on topic
- Content and Message
- Originality
- Presentation and Structure

Terms of Award

Saint John's #51 Scholarship Foundation requires that all students comply with the terms of the award offered at the time of their acceptance of the scholarship.

- **Completed scholarship application form** (included in this packet)
- **Completed scholarship agreement form** (included in this packet)
- **Completed personal information release form** (included in this packet)
- □ A personal statement or essay: Describe three leadership traits that will be important to your career responsibilities and explain why.
- □ (Please attach a separate sheet. Your essay should be 500 words or longer.)
- □ A copy of your High School or college transcript showing the most recent semester completed and your CGPA (this does NOT need to be an "official" transcript). An official transcript with a high school graduation date will need to be presented to the scholarship committee prior to disbursement of funds.
- □ A letter of recommendation from a teacher or administrator at your graduating high school or college program.
- □ A list of relatives who are current or past members of a Masonic lodge, if applicable. (This is for consideration of scholarships that may be designated for Masons)
